ORDINANCE NO. 289

AN ORDINANCE amending the 1959 Budget Ordinance No. 264 by decreasing certain unexpended items, making transfers between general classes within funds and between items within classes.

WHEREAS, Section 5 of Chapter 158 of the Laws of 1923, as embodied in R.C.W. 35.33.120, was amended by Chapter 322 of the Laws of 1955 to permit the City Council to readjust the municipal budget by making transfers of appropriated but unexpended funds from one general class to another class of appropriations and to permit transfer of unexpended funds for specific items to other items so that the same may be more advantageously expended to the best interest of the city; Now, therefore

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council does hereby find that those funds heretofore appropriated by Ordinance No. 264 and all amendments thereto, for the several classes and items listed below are not required for the city's operation in 1959 to the extent by which said funds and items are decreased in Section 4 below, and that the classes and items listed in Section 5 below require more funds for expenditure in 1959 than had been anticipated or were available in making appropriations in Ordinance No. 264, and all amendments thereto, and that it is to the best interests of the municipality to transfer funds appropriated in Ordinance No. 264 and all amendments thereto, so that the funds so transferred and reapropriated herein can be more advantageously expended in the rendition of municipal services in the year of 1959.

Section 2. No portion of the funds so transferred shall be used to increase the salary of any employee above that provided for in the 1959 Budget, and such transfer and reapropriation of funds herein will not constitute an increase or decrease of the entire budget of expenditures estimated and appropriated for the year 1959 by Ordinance No. 264, and all amendments thereto.

Section 3. Ordinance No. 264, passed by the City Council of the City of Bellevue on the 7th day of October, 1958, and all amendments thereto, classifying and itemizing the estimated expenditures of municipal funds for the year 1959 be, and the same hereby is, amended to the extent by which funds are decreased in Section 4 hereof and to the extent that transfers of funds are made between classes and items of expenditures as contained in Section 5 hereof.

Section 4. Subject to the existence of unexpended funds in each of the below listed items, the appropriations for such items as contained in Ordinance No. 264, and all amendments thereto, are recalled, revoked and decreased to the following extent:
