ORDINANCE NO. 2949

AN ORDINANCE regarding issuance and renewal of licenses for masseurs and masseuses; and amending Section 9 of Ordinance No. 2071 and Bellevue City Code 5.28.160.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 9 of Ordinance No. 2071 and Bellevue City Code 5.28.160 are hereby amended to read as follows:

5.28.160 Issuance and renewal of license - Masseur - Masseuse - Attendant - Referral to police department.

Upon the filing of an application for a license to act as a masseur, masseuse, public massage parlor attendant, or public bathhouse attendant the clerk shall refer the same to the police department with the request to investigate the statement contained in said application, and to furnish a written report within thirty days containing the results of the investigation and any other matters pertinent to said application.

If, from said report and other information it appears that the applicant is fit and proper, that the statements contained in the application are true, that the applicant has not been convicted of a crime involving moral turpitude or attempt to defraud and that the applicant has complied with all the requirements of the ordinance



codified herein, the clerk shall issue a license to the applicant; otherwise the license application shall be denied.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be published by posting it in the three official posting places of the City, and shall take effect and be in force five days after the date of posting.


