ORDINANCE NO. 2967

AN ORDINANCE relating to the Water System Code and Regulations of the City of Bellevue Waterworks Utility; amending Section VIII of said Code as adopted by Ordinance No. 2415 to authorize activation of additional street lights under certain emergency conditions.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section VIII of the Water System Code and Regulations of the City of Bellevue Waterworks Utility, adopted by Ordinance No. 2415, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section VIII: STREET LIGHTING:

As established under RCW 57.08.060 and RCW 35A.14.350, the Department of Public Works and Utilities may accept the obligation of billing and collecting for street lighting service in areas outside the boundaries of the City of Bellevue.

Such obligation shall be entered into only subsequent to actual installation of the street lighting facilities, and when it has been established that 90% of the benefited properties are occupied or when it has been determined by the Director of Public Works and Utilities or his designee that there exists a compelling and urgent need for activation of street lighting in order to help reduce theft, vandalism or other threats to public safety, provided that revenues from the properties being benefited are sufficient to cover the cost of the payment to the Puget Sound Power and Light Company, plus 20% administrative charge.

The billing charges for street lighting shall be based on actual cost as paid by the City of Bellevue to Puget Sound Power and Light Company, plus a 20% administrative charge. The charges will appear bi-monthly on the benefited customers' normal water/sewer billing.

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All lots within any development where street lights have been installed shall be considered as benefited by the street lights, as well as property that may lie outside of the plat, but adjacent to the plat.

Street lighting districts may be formed by the petition method from property owners, provided that 75% of the property owners sign the petition for the formation of the district.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be published by posting it in the three official posting place of the City and shall take effect and be in force five days after the date of posting.


