ORDINANCE NO. 305

AN ORDINANCE relating to taxicabs; setting rates, and amending Ordinance No. 46.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 3 of Ordinance No. 46, passed by the City Council on November 24, 1953, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 3. The following schedule of charges for taxicabs and for-hire cars is hereby established and adopted as the maximum rates that may be charged or collected in the City, and it shall be unlawful for any person driving or operating or engaged in the business of operating any taxicab or taxicabs, for-hire car or for-hire cars, to charge, demand, collect or receive any greater rate or fare than that specified herein:

TAXICAB RATES

For the first 1/4 mile or fraction thereof . . . 50¢
Thereafter, for each additional 1/4 mile . . . 10¢
For every two minutes of waiting . . . 10¢
For each additional passenger regardless of distance . . . 10¢

FOR-HIRE CAR RATES

For each hour. \$4.00"

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage, approval and legal publication.
