

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 307

AN ORDINANCE relating to motor vehicles; restricting truck traffic on certain streets, and amending Ordinance No. 27.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 27, passed by the City Council on July 7, 1953, be and the same is hereby amended by adding thereto Section 187, which shall read as follows:

"Section 187a. Through truck traffic is prohibited from N.E. 24th Street to Northrup Way, by way of 109th Pl. N.E.; N.E. 26th Pl.; 110th Ave. N.E.; and N.E. 28th St.

"Section 187b. 'Truck' is defined as any motor vehicle designed or used for the transportation of commodities, merchandise, produce, freight or animals.

"Section 187c. 'Through traffic' is defined as vehicles using a public street or highway for purposes of travel with no intention of stopping within the defined area, and with no legitimate business within the defined area."

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage, approval and legal publication.
