ORDINANCE NO. 314

AN ORDINANCE relating to swimming pools; providing for the fencing thereof, and prescribing penalties.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. All outdoor swimming pools heretofore or hereafter constructed, or presently under construction, within the City, shall be enclosed with a pool or yard fence of strength and design sufficient to resist the penetration of children, difficult to climb, and not less than four (4) feet high. A residence on the premises may be part of either of said fences. Any doors or gates in said fences, other than residence doors, shall be of the self-closing and self-latching type, with the opening device (1) operable only from the inside, or (2) located at least 54 inches from the ground.

Section 2. Any person violating this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine not exceeding \$250.00 or by imprisonment not to exceed ninety (90) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage, approval and legal publication.
