ORDINANCE NO. 332

AN ORDINANCE annexing a portion of Section 33, Township 25 North, Range 5 E., W.M., upon the petition of Bruce Holliday and others.

WHEREAS, a written petition was filed with the City Council of the City of Bellevue for the annexation of the territory herein described, and

WHEREAS, the City Council has examined the petition and has found, upon satisfactory proof, that the petition was signed by the owners of not less than 75 per cent in value, according to the assessed valuation for general taxation of the property therein described, and in all respects has met the requirements of Chapter 128, Laws of 1945 of the State of Washington, and any amendments thereto, and

WHEREAS, the City Council fixed the 27th day of October, 1959, as the date for public hearing thereon and caused notice of such hearing to be published and posted in accordance with the law, and the hearing having been held on said date; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the proposed annexation of territory will be conducive to the public health, welfare and convenience of the City of Bellevue and will be of special benefit to the land included within the boundaries of the territory proposed to be annexed.

Section 2. That the boundaries of the territory to be annexed to the City of Bellevue are hereby described as follows:

> That portion of Section 33, Township 25 North, Range 5 E., W.M., described as follows: Beginning at a point on the West line of Section 33, Township 25 North, Range 5 E., W.M., in King County, Washington, 575 feet North of the quarter section corner; thence North on said West line 90 feet; thence East at right angles to the West line of the Northern Pacific Railroad right of way; thence southerly on said line to a point where a line from the point of beginning and parallel to the North line described intersects the West line of the Northern Pacific Railroad right of way; thence West on said parallel line to the point of beginning.

Section 3. That all property within the territory so annexed shall be assessed and taxed at the same rate and on the same basis as other property within the City of Bellevue including assessments or taxes in payment of any bonds issued or debts contracted prior to or existing at the date of the annexation.

Section 4. That the above described territory shall become a part of the City of Bellevue on the <u>3</u> day of <u>moremly</u> 1959, and become subject to all of its laws and ordinances then and thereafter in force.

Section 5. That copies of this ordinance shall be filed with the Board of County Commissioners of King County, Washington. PASSED by the City Council on the 27th day of October, 1959, and signed in authentication of its passage this <u>27th</u> day of <u>October</u>, 1959.
