

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 334

AN ORDINANCE relating to land use; and adding Section 4.17.43 to Ordinance No. 68 as amended by Ordinance No. 317.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Chapter 4 of Ordinance No. 68, passed on the 28th day of September, 1954, as amended by Ordinance No. 317 passed on the 11th day of August, 1959, is hereby amended by adding thereto Section 4.17.43, which shall provide as follows:

"4.17.43 Gasoline and oil service is permitted provided:

1. The gasoline service dock is separated by a minimum of 4' from any other pier providing boat moorage. The only access shall be a pedestrian gangplank.
2. The gasoline sales shelter, located on the gas dock, shall not exceed 40 sq. ft. in area nor 8' in height with at least 1/3 of the wall areas glass. Oil storage in the sales shelter shall be limited to sealed containers of not over one gallon capacity. Fuel in cans or the portable storage of fuel is prohibited.
3. Docking space provided for transitory boats seeking supplies or services shall be independent of and separate from the gasoline dock or the rented moorage piers.
4. Bulk storage tanks for gasoline are located on shore."

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage, approval and legal publication.
