

BELLEVUE CITY ORDINANCE NO. 337

AN ORDINANCE authorizing expenditures from funds received in excess of estimated revenues in the year 1959.

WHEREAS, the two primary property owners, the Northern Pacific Railway Company and Safeway Stores, Inc., in the area of Lake Sturtevant, have agreed to be solely responsible for the cost of constructing an off-fall drain line from Lake Sturtevant, and

WHEREAS, there has been paid to the City of Bellevue the gross sum of Eight Thousand Dollars (\$8,000.00) to be used exclusively in defraying the cost of constructing approximately 316 lineal feet of reinforced concrete 30-inch culvert pipe, with necessary manholes and appurtenances, and

WHEREAS, the City has agreed to accept said sum and to use the same in making said improvement. If the costs run less than \$8,000.00, appropriate refunds will be made. If the costs run more than \$8,000.00, the above mentioned major property owners will make up the difference in cost, and

WHEREAS, such revenues so received, as hereinbefore recited, were not anticipated at the time of the preparation of the 1959 Budget, and it is to the best interest of the municipality that such excess revenues be appropriated as hereinafter recited, Now therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The 1959 Budget Ordinance No. 264, approved by the City Council on the 7th day of October, 1958, and all amendments thereto, is hereby amended by appropriating the funds received from sources not anticipated as hereinbefore recited and the same are budgeted and appropriated to the items and sections of the budget, by increasing the following budget item:

Section 2. The Clerk of the City of Bellevue is directed to transmit a certified copy of this ordinance to the Auditor of the State of Washington, Division of Municipal Corporations.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage, approval and legal publication.
