

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 339

AN ORDINANCE relating to sanitation, and amending Ordinance No. 75.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 2, of Ordinance No. 75, passed by the City Council on November 2, 1954, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 2. It shall be unlawful for any person, persons, or corporation, to throw, drain, run, or otherwise discharge into the waters of any stream or lake within the city of Bellevue, or to cause, permit, or suffer to be thrown, run, drained, allowed to seep, or otherwise discharged into such waters, or upon the land of another, any material that shall cause or tend to cause a polluted condition of such waters or land of another. It shall be deemed a violation of this section to permit the effluent from any drainage field or septic tank to run or seep into any ditch or stream, or upon the land of another, after a health official of the City of Bellevue shall have notified the owner or occupant of the premises on which said septic tank or drainage field is located, that the same has not been lawfully installed or is operating improperly."

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage, approval and legal publication.
