ORDINANCE NO. 340

AN ORDINANCE relating to nuisances, and amending Ordinance No. 43.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 6.3 (a) of Ordinance No. 43, passed by the City Council on November 10, 1953, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 6.3 (a). Any person who shall allow or permit upon any premises owned, occupied, or controlled by him, or who shall discharge or deposit or permit to seep upon the land of another, any substance detrimental to health, or any accumulation of filth, rubbish, garbage, decaying animal matter, vegetable matter, or any animal or human excrement, or septic tank effluent, shall be guilty of committing a public nuisance."

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage, approval and legal publication.
