

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 357

AN ORDINANCE authorizing expenditures from funds received in excess of estimated revenues in the year 1960.

WHEREAS, the Northern Pacific Railway Company and Safeway Stores, Inc., in 1959 paid to the City a sum of money to be used in defraying the cost of installing culvert pipe from Lake Sturtevant, as recited in Ordinance No. 337; said sum of money was not completely expended during the budget year 1959, with \$1,170.00 carried over into the 1960 budget year as a retained percentage; and

WHEREAS, such revenues so received, as hereinbefore recited, were not anticipated at the time of the preparation of the 1960 Budget, and it is to the best interest of the municipality that such excess revenues be appropriated as hereinafter recited; Now therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The 1960 Budget Ordinance No. 328, approved by the City Council on the 7th day of October, 1959, and all amendments thereto, is hereby amended by appropriating the funds received from sources not anticipated as hereinbefore recited and the same are budgeted and appropriated to the items and sections of the budget by increasing the following budget item:

Section 2. The Clerk of the City of Bellevue is directed to transmit a certified copy of this ordinance to the Auditor of the State of Washington, Division of Municipal Corporations.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage, approval and legal publication.
