## ORDINANCE NO. 3659

AN ORDINANCE relating to the licensing of "panorams," "previews," "picture arcades," or "peep shows"; amending Section 12 of Ordinance No. 3480, as amended by Section 7 of Ordinance No. 3559, and Section 5.44.110 of the Bellevue City Code.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 12 of Ordinance No. 3480, as amended by Section 7 of Ordinance No. 3559, and Bellevue City Code Section 5.44.110 are amended to read as followsL

## 5.44.110 Premises Regulations.

The Clerk shall not license any panoram premises which do not conform to the following requirements, and shall revoke or suspend the license of any panoram premises, and the license of any operator thereof, which do not maintain conformity with the following requirements:

- A. The interior of every panoram station shall be arranged in such a manner that the view from a continuous main aisle of any person viewing a panoram shall not be obstructed except by a door, curtain or other device the bottom of which is at least forty-two (42) inches from the floor.
- B. The licensee shall not permit any doors to areas on the premises which are available for use by persons other than the licensee or employees of the licensee to be locked during business hours.
- C. The licensee shall maintain illumination generally distributed in all parts of the premises available for use by the public, in compliance with the City of Bellevue Building Code (Chapter 23.10 of the Bellevue City Code), at all times when the premises are open or when any member of the public is permitted to enter and remain therein.
  - Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty
