

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 369

AN ORDINANCE annexing a portion of Section 28, Township 25 North, Range 5 East, W.M. upon the petition of Robert M. Hagen and others.

WHEREAS, a written petition was filed with the City Council of the City of Bellevue for the annexation of the territory herein described; and

WHEREAS the City Council has examined the petition and has found, upon satisfactory proof, that the petition was signed by the owners of not less than 75 per cent in value, according to the assessed valuation for general taxation of the property therein described, and in all respects has met the requirements of Chapter 128, Laws of 1945 of the State of Washington, and any amendments thereto; and

WHEREAS the City Council fixed December 22, 1959 as the date for public hearing thereon and caused notice of such hearing to be published and posted in accordance with the law, and said hearing having been continued to the date hereof; now therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the proposed annexation of territory will be conducive to the public health, welfare and convenience of the City of Bellevue and will be of special benefit to the land included within the boundaries of the territory proposed to be annexed.

Section 2. That the boundaries of the territory to be annexed to the City of Bellevue are hereby described as follows:

Beginning at the SE corner of the SW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Section 28, Township 25 N, Range 5 E, W.M., in King County, Washington, thence east on the south line of Section 28 to the center line of vacated Clancy Street of Brierwood Park, according to plat thereof, Volume 17, Page 18, records of said County, thence north on said centerline to the centerline of the Bellevue-Redmond Road, thence southwesterly on said centerline to the east line of the SW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Section 28, thence south on said east line to the point of beginning.

Section 3. That all property within the territory so annexed shall be assessed and taxed at the same rate and on the same basis as other property within the City of Bellevue including assessments or taxes in payment of any bonds issued or debts contracted prior to or existing at the date of the annexation.

Section 4. That the above described territory shall become a part of the City of Bellevue on the 7th day of June, 1960, and become subject to all of its laws and ordinances then and thereafter in force.

Section 5. That copies of this ordinance shall be filed with the Board of County Commissioners of King County, Washington.
