ORDINANCE NO. 3751

AN ORDINANCE relating to the filing of damage claims against City, amending Ordinance No. 2420 Section 2 (part), and Bellevue City Code 4.36.050.

The City Council of the City of Bellevue, Washington, does ordain as follows:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 2420 Section 2 (part) and Bellevue City Code 4.36.050, are hereby amended to read as follows:


4.36.050 FILING CLAIM WITH CITY CLERK MANDATORY.

No action shall be maintained against the city for damages arising out of tortious conduct until a claim has first been presented to and filed with the City Clerk. The requirements of this section shall not affect the applicable period of limitations within which an action must be commenced, but such period shall begin and shall continue to run as if no claim were required.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days after its passage and legal publication.


