## CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 3783

AN ORDINANCE relating to the Platting and Subdivisions Code; amending Section 2 (part) of Ordinance No. 3160, Section 1 of Ordinance No. 3499, and Bellevue City Code 22D.10.010 and 22D.10.030; and adding a new Section 22D.10.045.

WHEREAS, the City has adopted a Sensitive Area Overlay District and other regulations for the purpose of implementing the Natural Determinants Element of the Comprehensive Plan and protecting environmentally sensitive areas and resources; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable that new subdivisions be sensitive to the existence of natural features on the subject property and compatible with the Sensitive Area Overlay District; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bellevue has complied with the State Environmental Policy Act and with the City's Environmental Procedures Ordinance; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 2 (part) of Ordinance No. 3160 and Bellevue City Code 22D.10.010 are amended to read as follows:

22D.10.010 Purpose.

This chapter is adopted in furtherance of the comprehensive plan of the city. It is hereby declared that the regulations contained in this chapter are necessary for the protection and preservation of the public health, safety and general welfare in accordance with the standards established by the state of Washington (RCW Chapter 58.17) and established by the city of Bellevue to prevent the overcrowding of land; to lessen congestion in the streets and highways; to promote effective use of land; to promote safe and convenient travel by the public on streets and highways; to provide for adequate light and air; to facilitate adequate provision for water, sewerage, parks and recreation areas, sites for schools and school grounds and other public requirements; to provide for proper ingress and egress; to provide for the expeditious review and approval of proposed subdivisions which conform to zoning standards and local plans and policies; to adequately provide for the housing and commercial needs of the community; to protect Sensitive Areas as designated in the

Sensitive Area Overlay District and the Sensitive Area Notebook;  
and to require uniform monumenting of land subdivisions and conveyance by accurate legal description.

Section 2. Section 2 (part) of Ordinance No. 3160, Section 1 of Ordinance No. 3499 and Bellevue City Code 22D.10.030 are amended by the addition of the following definitions and all other definitions of that Section are renumbered to allow the alphabetical insertion of these new definitions:

"Protected Area" means an area designated under Bellevue City Code (Land Use Code) 20.25H.070 where use or development is subject to special limitations due to its physical characteristics.

"Sensitive Area" means an area mapped or defined in the City of Bellevue Sensitive Area Notebook as a Sensitive Area including Areas of Special Flood Hazard, Wetlands, Riparian Corridors and Slopes equal to or exceeding 15%.

Section 3. Bellevue City Code 22D.10 is amended by the addition of a new Section 22D.10.045 which reads as follows:

22D.10.045 Special Requirements for Sensitive Areas.

- A. A lot which contains a Sensitive Area must be configured in a manner which, to the maximum extent possible, will allow a structure to be built on the least sensitive portion of the site in conformance with the Performance Standards of Bellevue City Code (Land Use Code) 20.25H.110.
- B. A lot which contains a Protected Area must be configured in a manner which will allow a designated building pad to be located outside of any Protected Area or Protected Area setback.
- C. The City shall require as a condition of preliminary plat approval that no disturbance occur within the Protected Area or Protected Area setback unless otherwise permitted in Chapter 20.25H.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days after final passage by the City Council.


