CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 3893

AN ORDINANCE regarding gambling; prohibiting punchboards, pulltabs and social card games as commercial stimulants; and adding a new chapter 10A.78 to the Bellevue City Code.

WHEREAS, RCW 9.46.295 authorizes cities to prohibit certain gambling activities; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it is in the best interests of the public health, safety and welfare, to prohibit those gambling activities hereinafter designated; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. A new Chapter 10A.78 is hereby added to the Bellevue City Code, to read as follows:

10A.78 GAMBLING

Section 10A.78.010 Prohibition of Certain Types of Gambling. Any license issued under the authority of the State to engage in any gambling activities shall be legal authority to engage in the gambling activities for which the license was issued throughout the City of Bellevue, except that such a license is not legal authority to engage in the following gambling activities which, under the authority given the City by RCW 9.46.295, are prohibited within the City:

- A. The utilization of punchboards and/or pulltabs, as defined in RCW 9.46.0273 as now or hereafter amended, as a commercial stimulant to business.
- B. The conduct of social card games, as defined in RCW 9.46.0281 as now or hereafter amended, as a commercial stimulant to business.

Section 10A.78.020 Violation A Misdemeanor


Any violation of this Chapter is a misdemeanor.
