## ORDINANCE NO. 39

AN ORDINANCE adopting a City Budget for the year 1954.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Budget for the City of Bellevue for the year 1954, prepared and filed with the City Clerk and as approved by vote of the City Council this date after due notice and hearing be, and the same is hereby in all respects ratified and adopted as such Budget, same being by this reference incorporated herein as if fully set forth.

Section 2. That there be and are hereby allowed and established the following total sums for expenditure in each of the following classifications in said 1954 Budget, to-wit:

Maintenance and Operation	\$ 24,393.00
Capital Outlay	\$ 12,825.00
Street Fund	\$ 35,807.00
Interest and Bond Redemption	\$ 3,975.00
Total Expenditures	\$127,360.00
Less Receipts from sources other than taxation	\$127,360.00
Total budgeted for Expenditures	\$127,360.00

Section 3. That a copy of the Budget as hereby adopted be transmitted to the office of the State Auditor of Washington, Division of Municipal Corporations.

Section 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after its passage, approval and publication or posting.
