
CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON



AN ORDINANCE determining the public advantage in vacating portions of Southeast 11th Street, Grant Avenue Southeast, and 102nd Avenue Southeast.

WHEREAS, petitions were filed with the City Council to vacate portions of Southeast 11th Street, Grant Avenue Southeast, and 102nd Avenue Southeast, described below, by owners of more than two-thirds (2/3rds) of the private property abutting the same; and

WHEREAS, the City Council by resolution fixed the time for hearing said petitions, and gave notice thereof by posting and mailing in the manner required by law; and

WHEREAS, investigation was made as to the use of said streets and the public interest to be served or damaged by a change of use or vacation thereof; and

WHEREAS, a hearing was held upon said petitions on October 11th, 1960, at the time and place fixed in said resolution and notices, and as a result thereof the City Council having found that the vacation of said streets to the extent herein described would serve the public good; and no objections thereto being made by owners of private abutting property; Now therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The following streets in the City of Bellevue, to-wit:

- a. That portion of S.E. 11th St. lying between the west R/W line of Grant Avenue and the east R/W Line of 102nd Ave. S.E.;
- b. That portion of Grant Avenue S.E. lying between S.E. 10th St. and S.E. 11th St.;
- c. That portion of 102nd Ave. S.E. lying between the South right of way line of S.E. 11th St. and the South right of way line of S.E. 10th St.;

are vacated.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage, approval and legal publication.
