

BELLEVUE CITY ORDINANCE NO. 405

AN ORDINANCE authorizing expenditures from funds received in excess of estimated revenues in the year 1960.

WHEREAS, the residents and property owners of an area within the City of Bellevue and adjacent to certain portions of N.E. 13th, 14th, 15th, 16th, 17th, 23rd, 24th, 28th Streets and 28th Place; 100th Ave. N.E., 102nd Ave. N.E., 103rd Ave. N.E., ~~108th Ave. N.E.~~, 108th Ave. N.E. and S.E. 16th Street, desired improvement of said public streets, and

WHEREAS, the funds budgeted for street repair, maintenance, and improvement for the year 1960 were not sufficient to defray the cost of the improvement of the streets as desired by such residents and property owners, and

WHEREAS, such residents and property owners voluntarily raised and donated to the City the sum of Nineteen Thousand Five Hundred Fifty Four and 60/100 Dollars (\$19,554.60) for use upon such street improvements, and

WHEREAS, Fourteen Thousand Five Hundred Fifty Four and 60/100 Dollars (\$14,554.60) of such revenues so received, as hereinbefore recited were not anticipated at the time of the preparation of the 1960 Budget, and it is to the best interest of the municipality that such excess revenues be appropriated as herein after recited, Now therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The 1960 Budget Ordinance No. 328, approved by the City Council on the seventh day of October, 1959, and all amendments thereto is hereby amended by appropriating the funds received from sources not anticipated as hereinbefore recited and the same are budgeted and appropriated to the items and sections of the budget, by increasing the following budget item:

Section 2. The Clerk of the City of Bellevue is directed to transmit a certified copy of this ordinance to the Auditor of the State of Washington, Division of Municipal Corporations.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage, approval and legal publication.


