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## CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 4076

AN ORDINANCE fixing the salaries of City Councilmembers, amending Section 2 of Ordinance No. 3464, and providing for per diem compensation when acting as an official representative of the City.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 2 of Ordinance No. 3464 is amended to read as follows:

Section 2. City Councilmembers shall be compensated for services rendered to the City at the salary set forth below:

- A. A Councilmember whose term of office commenced prior to January 1, 1992, shall receive a salary of \$750.00 per month.
- B. A Councilmember whose term of office commenced prior to January 1, 1992, and who serves as Mayor shall receive a salary for serving as Mayor, in lieu of the salary set forth in subsection A., above, of \$900.00 per month.
- C. A Councilmember whose term of office commences on or after January 1, 1992, shall receive a salary of \$1,000.00 per month.
- D. A Councilmember whose term of office commences on or after January 1, 1992, and who serves as Mayor shall receive a salary for serving as Mayor, in lieu of the salary set forth in subsection C., above, of \$1,200.00 per month.

Section 2. In addition to the compensation set forth in Section 2, above, a Councilmember (including the Mayor) whose term of office commences on or after January 1, 1992, shall be compensated for services rendered to the City at a per diem rate of \$50.00 per day for each day during which he or she attends a meeting, other than a City meeting, while acting in the capacity of an official representative of the City, provided, no per diem shall be payable if he or she is entitled to receive per diem or other compensation from another source for such attendance; and provided, further, that the number of the days for which per diem compensation shall be payable hereunder for any person shall not exceed twelve (12) days in any month. The Mayor or a Councilmember shall be "acting in the capacity of an official representative of the City" for purposes of this section if he or she has been appointed or designated by the City Council or Mayor, or in the absence of the Mayor, the Mayor pro

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tem., to represent the City in regard to the meeting or meetings for which such compensation is claimed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after its passage and legal publication.
