CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 4133

AN ORDINANCE relating to the licensing of masseurs and masseuses, public massage parlors and public bath houses; providing an exemption from fingerprinting and background investigation requirements for state licensed masseurs and masseuses who have completed state educational requirements; and adding a new Section 5.28.165 to the Bellevue City Code.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. A new Section 5.28.165 is hereby added to Chapter 5.28 of the Bellevue City Code, to read as follows:


5.28.165 State Licensed Masseurs and Masseuses - Exemptions.

If an applicant for a masseur, masseuse, public massage parlor or public bath house license, or the renewal of such license, has completed the necessary educational requirements and obtained a massage practitioner's license pursuant to state law, the fingerprinting requirements of Section 5.28.070.G and 5.28.150.G, and the requirements for a background investigation of Section 5.28.080 and 5.28.160 of this chapter shall have no application.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days after passage.


