CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 4164

AN ORDINANCE relating to the 1990 operating budget; appropriating funds received in excess of estimated revenues; and amending Ordinance No. 4107, as amended by Ordinances Nos. 4143 and 4156

WHEREAS, RCW 35.21.070 authorizes the Council to establish a Cumulative Reserve Fund for specific municipal purposes; and

WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 3319, as amended by Ordinances Nos. 3473 and 4090, the Council has established a General Cumulative Reserve Fund, which includes a Building Permit Reserve Account to support permit issuance and inspection; and

WHEREAS, the Council now desires to transfer additional funds from the General Cumulative Reserve Fund to the General Fund to support permit review activities; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable to increase the appropriations to the General Fund supported by funds transferred from the General Cumulative Reserve Fund; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The fund affected by this ordinance and the changes to the 1990 budget adopted herein are summarized as follows:

The details of the budget changes adopted by this ordinance are set forth in that certain document entitled Attachment A, "Budget Detail", which has been given Clerk's Receiving No. 15769.

Section 2. Section 2 of the 1990 Budget Ordinance No. 4107 is hereby amended by appropriating unanticipated revenue received during the current fiscal year to the General Fund, in the amount specified in Section 1. The source of said funds is the General Cumulative Reserve Fund (Building Permit Reserve Account).


Section 3. The City Clerk is directed to transmit a certified copy of this ordinance to the Auditor of the State of Washington, Division of Municipal Corporations.

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Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after its passage and legal publications.




