ORDINANCE NO. 4191

AN ORDINANCE relating to the Bellevue Waterworks Utility; granting the finance director authority to refer certain utility accounts to a collection agency and write-off certain utility accounts; and amending Sections 3 of Ordinance No. 2809.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. Section 3 of Ordinance No. 2809, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 3. The Finance Director or his authorized representative shall have the authority to refer delinquent accounts of the Waterworks Utility and the Storm and Surface Water Utility to an agency for collection and write-off accounts that are over three years old in an amount not to exceed \$1,000.00 per account. This write-off option shall be utilized only after it has been determined by the Finance Director that the account is uncollectable and is not referable to a collection agency.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after its passage and legal publication.


