CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 4202

AN ORDINANCE amending the budget for a number of special purpose funds by appropriating unanticipated and future revenues to those funds.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The budget for each special purpose (non-budgetary) fund set forth below is hereby amended by appropriating to each such fund unanticipated and future revenues in excess of estimated revenues in the amounts set forth opposite each such fund:


Section 2. The City Clerk is directed to transmit a certified copy of this ordinance to the Auditor of the State of Washington, Division of Municipal Corporations.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after its passage and legal publication.


