ORDINANCE NO. 4227

AN ORDINANCE amending the budget for a number of special purpose funds by appropriating unanticipated and future revenues for those funds; creating the Criminal Justice Fund; and closing Fund No. 4800, the Utility Capital Fund.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 2. Fund No. 4800, the Utility Capital Fund, is hereby closed.

Section 3. There is hereby created and established a special purpose fund to be known as the Criminal Justice Fund, into which all funds received from the City's share of state funding for criminal justice shall be deposited to the credit of such special purpose fund and held separate and apart from all other funds.

Section 4. The City Clerk is directed to transmit a certified copy of this Ordinance to the Auditor of the State of Washington, Division of Municipal Corporations.
