CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 4236

AN ORDINANCE relating to the 1991 Operating Budget; appropriating funds received in excess of estimated revenues; and amending the 1991 Operating Budget adopted pursuant to Ordinance No. 4200.

WHEREAS, RCW 35A.33.120 permits the City Council to authorize expenditures from funds received in excess of estimated revenues by amendment of the budget; and

WHEREAS, the City's emergency preparedness program is a high priority program requiring funding in 1991; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable to increase the appropriation to the General Fund (010) by appropriating funds received in excess of estimated revenues during the current fiscal year; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Amendment of the General Fund (010) appropriations for the 1991 Operating Budget are summarized as follows:

GENERAL FUND (010)	\$69,620,753	\$50,000	\$69,670,753

The details of the budget changes adopted by this ordinance are set forth in that certain document entitled Attachment A, "Budget Detail", which has been given Clerk's Receiving No. 16434.

Section 2. Section 2 of Ordinance No. 4200, the 1991 Budget Ordinance, is hereby amended by appropriating unanticipated revenue received during the current fiscal year to the General Fund (010) in the amount set forth in Section 1 of this ordinance.

Section 3. The City Clerk is directed to transmit a certified copy of this ordinance to the Auditor of the State of Washington, Division of Municipal Corporations.



Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after its passage and legal publication.




