ORDINANCE NO. 4279

AN ORDINANCE repealing Bellevue City Code Chapter 5.40, Towing; and authorizing the City Manager to enter into Vehicle Impound Agreements.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Bellevue City Code Chapter 5.40, Towing, is hereby repealed.


Section 2. The City Manger is hereby authorized to enter into Vehicle Impound Agreements with qualified tow companies. The initial contracts shall be in substantially the form given Clerk's Receiving No. 17013.

Section 3. Pending execution of such Agreements, the City administration may adopt repealed Section 5.40.160 as an administrative procedure for handling impounds.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days after passage and legal publication.




