

## ORDINANCE NO. 433

AN ORDINANCE determining the public advantage in vacating portions of S.E. 8th Street and S.E. 18th Street.

WHEREAS petitions were filed with the City Council to vacate portions of Southeast 8th Street and Southeast 18th Street, described below, by owners of more than two-thirds (2/3rds) of the private property abutting the same; and

WHEREAS the City Council by resolutions fixed the time for hearing said petitions, and gave notice thereof by posting and mailing in the manner required by law; and

WHEREAS investigation was made as to the use of said streets and the public interest to be served or damaged by a change of use or vacation thereof; and

WHEREAS hearings were held upon said petitions on March 14th, 1961, at the time and place fixed in said resolutions and notices, and as a result thereof the City Council having found that the vacation of said streets to the extent herein described would serve the public good; and no objections thereto being made by owners of private abutting property: Now therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The following streets in the City of Bellevue, to-wit:

- a. That portion of S.E. 8th Street lying between the west right of way line of 107th Avenue S.E. and the west right of way line of 108th Avenue S.E.;
- b. That portion of S.E. 18th Street lying between 107th Avenue S.E. and 108th Avenue S.E.;

are vacated; provided however, that easements are reserved for the location, construction, reinstallation, use, repair and maintenance of pipes, poles, cables, lines or appurtenances of public utilities and services within or above such vacated portions.

Section 2. The Administration is hereby directed to record a certified copy of this Ordinance with the King County Auditor, and to file a certified copy of this Ordinance with the King County Assessor.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage, approval and legal publication.
