ORDINANCE NO. 4445

AN ORDINANCE regarding official bonds for city employees; amending Bellevue City Code Chapter 3.88.010 and repealing Bellevue City Code 3.88.020, .030, .040, .050 and .060.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Bellevue City Code 3.38.010 is amended to read as follows:

3.88.010 Employees requiring bonds - amount.

In accordance with RCW 35A.13.070 and RCW 35A.13.160, the following employees of the City shall each, before entering upon the performance of their respective duties, furnish to the city an official bond conditioned upon the honest and faithful performance and discharge of their official duties, and for the proper application of all money or property received by them by virtue of their position or employment, in at least the following amounts:

City Manager	\$5,000.00
City Treasurer	\$5,000.00
City Clerk	\$5,000.00
Police Chief	\$5,000.00

All such official bonds shall be approved by the City Manager, except that the bond of the City Manager shall be approved by the City Attorney. The premiums on such bonds shall be paid by the City.

Section 2. Bellevue City Code 3.88.020, .030, .040, .050 and .060 are hereby repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after passage and legal publication.


