

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 4551

AN ORDINANCE relating to sound amplification; modifying the exemption for special civic events; and amending Section 9.14.070A. of the Bellevue City Code.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Bellevue City Code Section 9.14.070A. and Section 7 (part) of Ordinance No. 51, as amended by Section 1 (part) of Ordinance No. 2443, are hereby amended to read as follows:

9.14.070 Limitations and conditions on use.

- A. No person shall operate or cause to be operated within the City any sound amplification equipment, the sound of which is plainly audible to persons on the streets or public grounds of the City, for any purpose except as set forth in Section 9.14.080 of this chapter; provided that this section does not apply to a special civic event which is defined as an event open to all members of the general public, held for a civic purpose, as distinguished from purposes prohibited in Sections 9.14.030 and 9.14.040, officially sanctioned by the Manager or the Manager's designee, and located and scheduled in such a manner as not to create a public nuisance and not to endanger the public safety, health or welfare.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days after its passage and legal publication.
