ORDINANCE NO. 4655

AN ORDINANCE regarding Special Events; providing that the requirement that notice of intent to stage a special event need not be filed sixty days in advance for city sponsored or co-sponsored events; and amending Section 1 (part) of Ordinance 4622 and Bellevue City Code 14.50.090.A.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 1 (part) of Ordinance 4622 and Bellevue City Code 14.50.090.A are amended to read as follows:

A. A Notice of Intent must be submitted to the City by the special event applicant/sponsor, listing location/route, date and time. The Notice of Intent must be filed at least 60 days prior to the date of the proposed event to allow adequate review time; provided this requirement shall not apply to a special event which is sponsored or co-sponsored by the City. A Notice of Intent for Annual Events must be submitted by January 15th of the year in which the event is to be held. First time events will be required to list several options for location, route, date and time.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after its passage and legal publication.


