ORDINANCE NO. 468

AN ORDINANCE authorizing the transfer of cash from General Obligation Street Improvement Bonds, 1961, to the Street Fund to correct an error.

WHEREAS, during 1960, arterial streets were restored in connection with Bellevue Sewer District ULID #8, and \$11,898.30 of the cost thereof should have been paid from the proceeds of the sale of general obligation street improvement bonds, but inadvertently was paid from the Street Fund; and


WHEREAS, it is now necessary to transfer cash from the proceeds of the sale of general obligation street improvement bonds to the Street Fund to replenish said Street Fund and make the necessary correction Now Therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Administrative personnel are hereby authorized to transfer from General Obligation Street Improvement Bonds, 1961, to the Street Fund, the sum of \$11,898.30.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage, approval and legal publication.
