

ORDINANCE NO. 47

AN ORDINANCE amending Ordinance No. 27, known as the Traffic Ordinance, by amending Chapter IV; amending Sections 112 and 113 of Chapter XI; amending Chapter XIII, by the addition of Section 137; and amending Section 182 of Chapter XVIII, entitled Specially Designated Streets.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Chapter IV of Ordinance No. 27, adopted by the City of Bellevue on the 21st day of July, 1953, is amended by adopting a Section 43, which shall provide as follows:

"Sec. 43. Regulation of speed by establishing speed limits. The speed limits on all streets shall be 25 miles per hour except (a) those posted as school zones within which the speed limit shall be 20 miles per hour, and (b) the following named streets on which the speed limit shall be:

- MAIN STREET, from 100th Avenue N. E. to 108th Avenue N. E. 20 MPH
- MAIN STREET, from 108th Avenue N. E. to 116th Avenue N. E. 35 MPH
- 116TH AVENUE N. E., from N. E. 8th Street to Northrup Way 35 MPH
- NORTHRUP WAY, from 132nd Avenue N. E. to 104th Avenue N. E. 35 MPH
- 104TH AVENUE N. E., from N. E. 10th Street to North City Limits 35 MPH
- N. E. 8TH STREET, from Bellevue-Redmond Road to 108th Avenue N. E., from 100th Avenue N. E. to N. E. 1st Street 35 MPH
- LAKE WASHINGTON BOULEVARD, from 104th Avenue S. E. to S. E. 34th Street 35 MPH
- 108TH AVENUE S. E., from Lake Washington Boulevard to S. E. 34th Street 35 MPH
- 116TH AVENUE, from South City Limits to N. E. 8th Street 50 MPH
- BELLEVUE-REDMOND ROAD, from 132nd Avenue N. E. to N. E. 8th Street 50 MPH "

Sec. 2. Sections 112 and 113 of Chapter XI of said Traffic Ordinance, adopted by the City of Bellevue on the 21st day of July, 1953 are hereby amended by repealing the said Sections 112 and 113 of Chapter XI, and adopting in lieu of the repealed section, the following:

"Sec. 112. License required. No person who resides within this city, shall ride or propel a bicycle on any street or upon any public path set aside for the exclusive use of bicycles unless such bicycle has been licensed and a license decal is attached thereto as provided herein.

"(a) License application. Application for a bicycle license and license decal shall be made upon a form provided by the city and shall be made to the chief of police. A license fee of Fifty Cents (\$.50) shall be paid to the city for first registration before each license or transfer thereof is granted. Renewals after first year shall be Twenty-Five Cents (\$.25). Duplicate license decals may be supplied for the same cost as the original decal in event of destruction of decal.

"(b) Issuance of License. The chief of police upon receiving proper application therefor is authorized to issue a bicycle license which shall be effective until transfer of ownership of said bicycle, said license to be good for one year. The chief of police shall not issue a license for any bicycle when he knows or has reasonable ground to believe that the applicant is not owner of, or entitled to the possession of, such bicycle.

"(c) Inspection of bicycles. The chief of police, or an officer assigned such responsibility, shall inspect each bicycle before licensing the same and shall refuse a license for any bicycle which he determines is in unsafe mechanical condition.

"(d) The chief of police shall keep a record of the number of each license, the date issued, the name and address of the person to whom issued, the number on the frame of the bicycle for which issued, and a record of all bicycle license fees collected by him.

"(e) Attachment of license decal. The chief of police, upon issuing a bicycle license, shall also issue a license decal bearing the license number assigned to the bicycle and the name of the city.

"(f) The chief of police shall cause such license decal to be placed on the frame of the bicycle for which issued in such position as to be plainly visible.

"(g) No person shall remove a license decal from a bicycle during the period for which issued except upon a transfer of ownership or in the event the bicycle is dismantled and no longer operated upon any street in the city.

"Sec. 113. Transfer of ownership. Upon the sale or other transfer of a licensed bicycle, the licensee shall remove the license decal and shall either surrender the same to the chief of police or may upon proper application have said decal assigned to another bicycle owned by the applicant.

"(a) Rental agencies. A rental agency shall not rent or offer any bicycle for rent unless the bicycle is licensed and a license decal is attached thereto as provided herein and such bicycle is equipped with the lamps and other equipment required in this chapter.

"(b) Bicycle dealers. Every person engaged in the business of buying or selling new or second-hand bicycles shall make a report to the chief of police of every bicycle purchased or sold by such dealer, giving the name and address of the person from whom purchased or to whom sold, a description of such bicycle by name or make, the frame number thereof, and the number of license decal, if any, found thereon."

Sec. 3. Chapter XIV, entitled Stopping, Standing, or Parking Restricted on Certain Streets, of the Traffic Ordinance, adopted by the City of Bellevue on the 21st day of July, 1953 is hereby amended by the addition of Section 158, as follows:

"Sec. 158. Parking prohibited over 24 hours. No person shall park any vehicle upon any public street, alley or way or leave said vehicle in the same public place for a period exceeding 24 hours. "

Sec. 4. Section 182 of Chapter XVIII of the Traffic Ordinance, adopted by the City of Bellevue on the 21st day of July, 1953 is hereby amended by repealing the said Section 182 of Chapter XVIII, and adopting in lieu of the repealed section, the following:

"Sec. 182. Arterial highways. In accordance with the provisions of Sec. 72 and when signs are erected giving notice thereof, operators of vehicles shall stop at every intersection before entering any of the following streets or parts of streets:

MAIN STREET, from 100th Avenue N. E. to 116th Avenue N. E.,
except at the light at 104th Avenue N. E.

LAKE WASHINGTON BOULEVARD, from Main Street to the City
Limits at N. E. 10th Street.

LAKE WASHINGTON BOULEVARD, from 104th Avenue S. E. to
S. E. 34th Street, except the northbound traffic at
S. E. 16th Street.

104TH AVENUE S. E., from Main Street to S. E. 27th Street,
except northbound traffic at Lake Washington Boulevard.

104TH AVENUE N. E., from Main Street to North City Limits,
except at the light at N. E. 8th Street.

108TH AVENUE N. E., from Main Street to N. E. 24th Street,
except at N. E. 8th Street.

108TH AVENUE S. E., from Main Street to S. E. 34th Street,
except at Lake Washington Boulevard.

100TH AVENUE N. E., from Main Street to N. E. 24th Street,
except at N. E. 8th Street.

116TH AVENUE, from South City Limits to Northrup Way, except
at N. E. 8th Street.

N. E. 8TH STREET, from junction with Bellevue-Redmond
Highway to its junction with N. E. 1st Street, except at
traffic light at 104th Avenue N. E.

N. E. 1ST STREET, from 104th Avenue N. E. to N. E. 10th
Street, except at 100th Avenue N. E. and its junction
with N. E. 8th Street.

N. E. 4TH STREET, from 108th Avenue N. E. to 98th Avenue
N. E., except at 104th Avenue N. E.

N. E. 5TH STREET, from 100th Avenue N. E. to N. E. 8th Street.

N. E. 24TH STREET, from 108th Avenue N. E. to 98th Avenue N. E., except at 104th Avenue N. E.


S. E. 34TH STREET, from Lake Washington Boulevard to 108th Avenue S. E.

NORTHRUP WAY, from 132nd Avenue N. E. to 104th Avenue N. E.


BELLEVUE-REDMOND ROAD, from 132nd Avenue N. E. to N. E. 8th Street. "

Sec. 5. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect five days from and after its passage, approval and legal publication.




