ORDINANCE NO. 4715

AN ORDINANCE regarding the Municipal Art Program; and amending Section 2 of Ordinance 3712, as previously amended by Section 1 of Ordinance 3797, and Bellevue City Code 4.48.030.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 2 of Ordinance 3712, as previously amended by Section 1 of Ordinance 3797, and Bellevue City Code 4.48.030 are amended to read as follows:

4.48.030 Municipal art fund.

There is hereby created and established a special purpose interest-bearing fund designated the "Municipal Art Fund" into which shall be deposited moneys described in this chapter, together with such other moneys as the city council shall designate for works of art. Money so deposited shall be expended for the selection, acquisition, display and/or maintenance of works of art. Such works of art shall be placed outside or inside of any construction project of any public agency or other publicly owned, leased, or rented property in locations where they are readily accessible for public viewing. No work of art may be placed in any office or other area not open to the general public. Such works of art may be attached or detached about such property and may be either temporary or permanent.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after its passage and legal publication.
