ORDINANCE NO. 478

AN ORDINANCE relating to land use; changing the zoning classification of annexed areas, and amending Ordinance Nos. 68 and 275.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 2.2 of Ordinance No. 68 passed September 28, 1954, as amended by Ordinance No. 275 passed January 13, 1959, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 2.2 All lands not classified according to the established Use District classifications on the official Essential Use District Map and Sectional Area District Maps, and all land not shown on said maps, shall be considered tentatively classified R-A, pending study, public hearing and specific classification. All land hereafter annexed to the City shall be considered tentatively as having the land use classification such land enjoyed while in the County, pending study, public hearing and specific classification."

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage, approval and legal publication.
