ORDINANCE NO. 479

AN ORDINANCE relating to Local Improvement District No. 59-S-12; reducing the width of the right-of-way and the estimated cost of Unit A, and amending Ordinance No. 465.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 465 passed October 24, 1961, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 1. Improvements ordered. The area described in Section 2 hereof shall be improved by the construction and installation of N.E. 6th Street from 104th Avenue N.E. to 108th Avenue N.E. (hereinafter called "Unit A"); and N.E. 6th Street from 108th Avenue N.E. to 112th Avenue N.E., plus 110th Avenue N.E. from N.E. 6th Street to ~~110th Avenue N.E.~~ ^{450' N. N.E. 2nd} Street, (hereinafter called "Unit B"); all of the foregoing within the two (2) continuous units of the improvement. Unit A shall be improved by paving the same with asphalt cement concrete (commonly referred to as "plant mix"), including the securing of necessary easements and rights-of-way, and including grading, re-grading, filling, compacting, ballasting, surfacing and draining, and the installation of drain inlets, storm sewers and other appurtenances consistent with good street construction. The right-of-way shall be 50 feet in width, and the traveled way shall be ~~44~~ ⁴⁰ feet wide. Unit B shall be improved by paving the same with asphalt cement concrete (commonly referred to as "plant mix"), including the securing of necessary easements and rights-of-way, and including grading, re-grading, filling, compacting, ballasting, surfacing and draining, and the installation of culverts and other appurtenances consistent with good street construction. The right-of-way shall be 60 feet in width, and the traveled way shall be 24 feet wide, all in accordance with plans and specifications to be prepared and submitted by the City Engineer."

Section 2. Section 5 of Ordinance No. 465 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 5. Estimated Cost. The estimated cost and expense of said street and sewers is hereby declared to be \$ 280,853.00, consisting of Unit A \$ 250,640.50 and Unit B \$ 30,212.50."

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage, approval and legal publication.
