ORDINANCE NO. 4888

AN ORDINANCE relating to the administrative award of certain public works and improvement contracts; amending Section 4.28.140 of the Bellevue City Code, as most recently amended by Section 2 of Ordinance No. 4320; and establishing an effective date.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 4.28.140 of the Bellevue City Code, as most recently amended by Section 2 of Ordinance No. 4320, is amended to read as follows:

4.28.140 When bids required for public works and improvements.

Except as otherwise authorized by Chapters 39.04 and 39.28 RCW, or RCW 35.22.620, relating to emergency public works, or other applicable general state law, as now enacted or as hereafter amended, all public works and improvements shall be done by contract pursuant to public notice and call for competitive bids in accordance with BCC 4.28.040 hereof whenever the estimated cost of such public work or improvement, including the cost of materials, supplies, equipment and labor will exceed the sum of \$35,000 if more than one craft or trade is involved with the public works project, or in excess of \$20,000 if only a single craft or trade is involved with the public works project or the public works project is street signalization or street lighting; provided, the city may use a small works roster pursuant to RCW 35.22.620.

Whenever the estimated cost of the public work or improvement is less than the amounts provided above, a contract for the public work or improvement may be awarded by the applicable department director, or other person designated by the city manager, consistent with the procedures set forth in BCC 4.28.050, 4.28.060 and 4.28.070 for the purchases of materials, supplies and equipment or, within the limits and to the extent authorized by RCW 35.22.620(2), the public work or improvement shall be performed by city employees.

The City Manager, or his designee, is authorized to accept the public works and improvements performed under any contract awarded hereunder after determining that such work has been satisfactorily completed in accordance with the contract terms thereof.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days after its passage.
