ORDINANCE NO. 516

AN ORDINANCE relating to fires; and amending Section 15.04.040 of Bellevue City Code.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 15.04.040 of Bellevue City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

15.04.040 Districts where aboveground storage of flammable liquids prohibited. A. LIMITS IN SECTION 16.22. The provisions of Section 16.22 of the Fire Prevention Code shall apply to Class I, II and III, flammable liquids. The limits referred to in said Section, in which storage of flammable liquids in outside above ground tanks is prohibited, are hereby established as follows: Fire Zones 1 and 3.

B. LIMITS IN SECTION 16.51. The limits referred to in Section 16.51 of the Fire Prevention Code, in which new bulk plants for flammable liquids are prohibited, are hereby established as follows: Fire Zones 1 and 3.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage, approval and legal publication.
