ORDINANCE NO. 518

AN ORDINANCE relating to service driveways; and amending Section 10.16.050 of Bellevue City Code.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 10.16.050 of Bellevue City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

10.16.050 Service driveway construction.

- A. GENERAL SPECIFICATIONS. All service driveways must be constructed according to specifications of this chapter and under the direction of the City Engineer.
- B. MATERIALS. All service driveways adjacent to a hardsurfaced public street shall be hard-surfaced. Service
 driveways which cross a curb constructed of Portland
 cement concrete shall be constructed of Portland cement
 concrete. Provided however, that the foregoing shall,
 in single family residence districts, apply only to
 service driveways to group parking areas.
- C. THICKNESS. Service driveways which are required under the terms hereof to be constructed of Portland cement concrete, and which are in areas zoned R-S, R-SL, B-N, B-1, B-2, B-2L, C-1, C-2 and C-M, shall be of twenty-five hundred psi concrete and shall be at least seven inches thick. Other service driveways, required under the terms hereof to be constructed of Portland cement concrete, shall be of twenty-five hundred psi concrete, and shall be at least five inches thick.
- D. CURB RETURNS AND EXPANSION JOINTS. Curb returns and expansion joints shall conform with the standard specifications of the City Engineer.
- E. ANGLE OF CROSSING PARKING STRIP AND SIDEWALK. All service driveways shall cross the outer parking strip and the sidewalk at an angle of not less than thirty degrees to the curb line.
 - F. DRAINAGE. All service driveways shall be constructed in such a manner that water will not run onto the sidewalk from the abutting property.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage, approval and legal publication.
