ORDINANCE NO. 519

AN ORDINANCE regarding the Planning Commission; requiring continued residence inside the City on the part of the members thereof, and amending the Bellevue City Code.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 3.58.011 of Bellevue City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

3.58.011 Residence of members. No person shall be competent to qualify for or hold the office of member of the Planning Commission unless he be a resident of the City. The office of member of the Planning Commission shall become vacant upon such member ceasing to be a resident of the City. Provided however, that the foregoing shall not apply to present members of the Planning Commission who presently reside outside the City.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage, approval and legal publication.
