## CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

## ORDINANCE NO. 5208

AN ORDINANCE adopting the recommended uses for supplemental 2000 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds as transmitted by the Human Services Commission; amend the 2000 - 2003 Consolidated Housing and Community Development Plan's 2000 Annual Action Plan to include additional projects; creating a new project series within the Operating Grants and Donations Fund; and authorizing the City Manager to enter into contracts with local human services agencies.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The 2000-2003 consolidated Housing & Community Development Plan's 2000 Annual Action Plan is hereby amended to include additional projects as provided in Attachment 1 to this Ordinance and a new project series within the Operating Grants & Donation Funds into which said monies for the additional projects shall be deposited.

Section 2. The recommendations from the Bellevue Human Services Commission for the use of supplemental 2000 CDBG (Community Block Grant) funds, as set forth in the amended 2000-2003 Consolidated Housing and Community Development Plan, as set forth in the document given Clerk's Receiving No. **28494**, are hereby adopted.

Section 3. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to expend the received monies as authorized in said grant award contract.

Section 4. The City manager or his designated representative shall have responsibility for the administration of said grant monies and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements with local human services agencies for the provision of community services in the amount authorized by the City Council.

The Finance Director or his designee is authorized to make interfund loans from the appropriate City fund to the Operating Grants and Donations Fund in whatever amounts, for whatever duration and under whatever terms are appropriate and necessary to cover cash flow shortages in the Operating Grants and Donations Fund that may be caused by this grant.

Section 7. The City Clerk is directed to transmit a certified copy of this Ordinance to the Auditor of the State of Washington, Division of Municipal Corporations.

Section 8. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after its passage and legal publication.
