ORDINANCE NO. 521

AN ORDINANCE regarding the Building Code Board of Appeals; requiring continued residence inside the City on the part of members thereof, and amending the Bellevue City Code.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 3.50.031 of Bellevue City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

3.50.031 Residence of members. No person shall be competent to qualify for or hold the office of a voting member of the Building Code Board of Appeals unless he be a resident of the City. The office of voting member of the Building Code Board of Appeals shall become vacant upon such member ceasing to be a resident of the City. Provided however, that the foregoing shall not apply to present members of the Building Code Board of Appeals who presently reside outside the City.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage, approval and legal publication.
