ORDINANCE NO. 523

AN ORDINANCE regarding the Board of Trustees of the Bellevue City Library; requiring continued residence inside the City on the part of the members thereof, and amending the Bellevue City Code.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Chapter 3.66 of Bellevue City Code is hereby amended by adding thereto Section 3.66.031 which shall read as follows:

3.66.031 Residence of members. No person shall be competent to qualify for or hold the office of member of the Board of Trustees of the Bellevue City Library unless he be a resident of the City. The office of member of the Board of Trustees of the Bellevue City Library shall become vacant upon such member ceasing to be a resident of the City. Provided however, that the foregoing shall not apply to present members of the Board of Trustees of the Bellevue City Library who presently reside outside the City.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage, approval and legal publication.
