ORDINANCE NO. 524

AN ORDINANCE regarding the City Civil Service Commission; requiring continued residence inside the City on the part of the members thereof, and amending the Bellevue City Code.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 3.72.020 of Bellevue City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

3.72.020 Membership. The Commission shall be composed of three members who shall be appointed by the City Manager and who shall serve without compensation. The Commissioners shall have the qualifications prescribed by R.C.W. 41.12.030, provided that no person shall be competent to qualify for or hold the office of member of the City Civil Service Commission unless he has been a resident of the City continuously for three years, as provided by R.C.W. 41.12.030. The office of member of the City Civil Service Commission shall become vacant upon such member ceasing to be a resident of the City. Provided however, that the foregoing shall not apply to present members of the City Civil Service Commission who presently reside outside the City.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage, approval and legal publication.
