ORDINANCE NO. 517

ORIGINAL

AN ORDINANCE relating to vehicles; providing for the regulation thereof and of persons in relation thereto; amending Chapters 11.82, 11.48, 11.36, 11.08 and 11.72 of Bellevue City Code, and repealing certain sections of Chapters 11.24, 11.28 and 11.04 thereof.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Chapter 11.82 of Bellevue City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

11.82.010 Statutes adopted by reference designated. The following Sections of Chapter 12, Laws of 1961, are hereby adopted by this reference:

Section 2. Chapter 11.48 of Bellevue City Code is hereby amended by adding thereto Sections ~~11.48.070~~, 11.48.080, 11.48.090, 11.48.100 and 11.48.110 which shall read as follows:

~~11.48.070 OVERTAKING AND PASSING ANOTHER VEHICLE - REQUIREMENTS - SOUNDING HORN~~

~~Any person driving a vehicle upon any public highway of this city and overtaking another vehicle proceeding in the same direction shall pass to the left of such overtaken vehicle: PROVIDED, That it shall be unlawful for any person to pass any vehicle overtaken unless he shall have a clear and unobstructed view ahead for a distance sufficient for safe passing, all factors considered. Any person driving a vehicle upon any public highway and being overtaken by any vehicle proceeding in the same direction shall keep to the extreme right hand side of such public highway and shall not accelerate his speed until the overtaking vehicle shall have resumed a driving position and speed ahead of him. The overtaking vehicle shall drive clear of the overtaken vehicle and shall continue its overtaking speed until it has passed the overtaken vehicle and shall have resumed its driving position to the right of such public highway. No person driving any vehicle upon any public highway of this city and overtaking another vehicle proceeding in the same direction shall overtake such vehicle or drive within a distance of less than fifty feet of such overtaken vehicle for such purpose without first signaling his intention to pass by use of horn or other sounding device. The provisions of this section shall not apply to the overtaking and passing of vehicles upon the proper driving portions of any~~

11.48.080 OVERTAKING AND PASSING ON CURVES, GRADES, TUNNELS, AND GRADE CROSSINGS - EXCEPTION - MARKING DANGER SPOTS.

It shall be unlawful for any person operating a vehicle upon a public highway of this city to overtake and pass another vehicle proceeding in the same direction upon a curve when the view of the operator of the overtaking vehicle is obstructed or obscured within a distance of eight hundred feet along the highway in the direction in which he is proceeding.

It shall be unlawful for any person operating a vehicle upon a public highway of this city to overtake and pass another vehicle proceeding in the same direction while approaching the crest of any grade where there is not a clear view of the highway ahead within a distance of eight hundred feet along the highway.

It shall be unlawful for any person operating a vehicle upon a public highway of this city to overtake and pass another vehicle proceeding in the same direction upon any highway structure, tunnel, or underpass, or within five hundred feet of the approach thereto.

It shall be unlawful for any person operating a vehicle upon a public highway of this city to overtake and pass another vehicle proceeding in the same direction while upon or within two hundred feet of the approach thereto of any highway railroad grade crossing.

It shall be unlawful for any person operating a vehicle upon a public highway of this city to overtake and pass another vehicle proceeding in the same direction while upon or within two hundred feet of the approach to an intersection area.

Between the points herein designated, vehicles shall remain to the extreme right hand side of the driving portion of the roadway.

The provisions of this section shall not apply to the overtaking and passing of vehicles upon the proper driving portions of a multiple-lane highway.

11.48.090 NO PASSING ZONES

The city engineer may, when he deems it necessary for safe vehicle operation, install no-passing zones by means of a solid barrier paint line of contrasting color parallel, adjacent, and to the right of the painted barrier line of the traffic lane in which the vehicle is operating and which shall be visible to the vehicle operator to designate points between which vehicles may not lawfully overtake and pass another vehicle proceeding in the same direction.

11.48.100 ARM AROUND ANOTHER

It shall be unlawful for any person to operate a motor vehicle upon the highways of this city when such person has his or her arm around another person in a manner which would prevent the free and unhampered operation of such vehicle.

The offense of operating a vehicle with arm around another shall be considered to be a lesser offense than, but included in, the offense of operating a vehicle while embracing another. Any person violating the provisions of this section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

11.48.110 INATTENTION

It shall be unlawful for any person to operate a motor vehicle in an inattentive manner over the highways of this city. For the purpose of this section, "inattentive" shall be construed to mean the operation of a vehicle upon the public highways of this city in a lax or slack manner. The offense of operating a motor vehicle in an inattentive manner shall be considered to be a lesser offense than, but included in, the offense of operating a vehicle in a negligent manner. Any person violating the provisions of this section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

Section 3. Chapter 11.36 of Bellevue City Code is hereby amended by adding thereto Sections 11.36.050 and 11.36.060 which shall read as follows:

11.36.050 MAKING "U" TURNS, RESTRICTIONS ON.

It shall be unlawful for any person operating any vehicle upon a public highway of this city to turn the same so as to proceed in an opposite direction at any other point than street intersection or street end.

11.36.060 CUTTING CORNER

It shall be unlawful for any person operating a motor vehicle upon the highways of this city to turn such vehicle either to right or to left upon approaching an intersection and to proceed across any private property for the purpose of avoiding the intersection, unless so directed by proper authorities. Any person violating the provisions of this section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

Section 4. Chapter 11.08 of Bellevue City Code is hereby amended by adding thereto Section 11.08.061 which shall read as follows:

11.08.061 RECORD OF TRANSACTIONS.

A dealer shall complete and maintain a record of the purchase and sale of all motor vehicles, motorcycles or trailers, purchased or sold by him and which have been previously licensed in this or another state, which record shall consist of:

- (1) The license and title numbers of state in which last license was issued;
- (2) A description of vehicle;
- (3) The name of person from whom purchased;
- (4) The name of legal owner, if any; and
- (5) The name of purchaser.

Such record shall at all times be available for inspection by any state, county or municipal police officer.

Section 5. Chapter 11.72 of Bellevue City Code is hereby amended by adding thereto Section 11.72.090 which shall read as follows:

11.72.090 PROHIBITED PARKING PLACES.

- (1) No person shall stop, stand, or park a vehicle, except when necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic or in compliance with the directions of a peace officer or traffic control device, in any of the following places:
 - (a) On a sidewalk or parking strip;
 - (b) In front of a public or private driveway or within five feet of said driveway;
 - (c) Within an intersection;
 - (d) Within fifteen feet of a fire hydrant;
 - (e) On a crosswalk or within twenty feet of a crosswalk at an intersection;
 - (f) Within thirty feet upon the approach to any flashing beacon, stop sign, or traffic control signal located at the side of a roadway;
 - (g) Within thirty feet of the nearest rail of a railroad crossing;
 - (h) Within fifty feet of the driveway entrance to any fire or police station or on the side of a street opposite the entrance to any fire station within seventy-five feet of said entrance when properly sign posted;
 - (i) Alongside or opposite any street excavation or obstruction when such stopping, standing, or parking would obstruct traffic;
 - (j) Upon any bridge or other elevated structure upon a highway or within a highway tunnel;
- (2) At any place where official signs prohibit stopping.

Section 6. Sections 11.24.010, 11.24.020, 11.24.030, 11.24.040, 11.24.050, 11.28.040, 11.28.050, 11.28.060, 11.28.070, 11.04.090 and 11.04.070 of Bellevue City Code are hereby repealed.

Section 7. The foregoing amendments and repeals shall not be construed as affecting any existing right acquired under the sections amended or repealed, not as affecting any proceeding instituted thereunder, nor any rule, regulation or order promulgated thereunder, nor any administrative action taken thereunder.

Section 8. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage, approval and legal publication.
