ORDINANCE NO. 530

AN ORDINANCE relating to the improvement of N.E. 6th Street and of 110th Avenue N.E.; and repealing Ordinance No. 488.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 488 passed by the City Council on January 12, 1962, and repassed by the City Council on January 23, 1962, and ordering the improvement of N.E. 6th Street from 104th Avenue N.E. to 112th Avenue N.E., plus 110th Avenue N.E. from N.E. 6th Street to a point 215 feet south of the centerline of N.E. 8th Street, is hereby repealed.
