

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 5314

AN ORDINANCE providing for interim on-street vehicle parking along both sides of 110<sup>th</sup> Avenue N.E. in the Downtown Area of the City, until December 31, 2005; and amending Section 2 of Ordinance No. 4927.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 2. of Ordinance No. 4927, as amended, is hereby amended to add a new paragraph W., to read as follows:

Section 2. Parking of vehicles on the following streets, or portions of streets, is restricted to "Two Hour Parking From 7 a.m. To 6 p.m., Except Sundays And Holidays:"

. . . .

W. Both sides of 110<sup>th</sup> Avenue NE between NE 8<sup>th</sup> Street and NE 10<sup>th</sup> Street, and the east side of 110<sup>th</sup> Avenue NE between NE 10<sup>th</sup> Street and NE 12<sup>th</sup> Street.

Section 2. New paragraph W. added to Section 2. of Ordinance No. 4927 by Section 1. of this ordinance shall expire and be of no further force or effect at 11:59 p.m. on December 31, 2005.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days after final passage by the City Council.
