ORDINANCE NO. 542

AN ORDINANCE relating to the 1962 Budget; and authorizing expenditures from funds received in excess of estimated revenues in 1962.

WHEREAS the City park department has received monies in the form of registration fees from participants in the summer recreation program; and

WHEREAS the funds so received were not anticipated at the time of the preparation of the 1962 Budget; and

WHEREAS it is to the best interests of the City that such excess revenues be appropriated as hereinafter recited; Now therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The 1962 Budget Ordinance No. 470, approved by the City Council on the 2nd day of October, 1961, and all amendments thereto, is hereby amended by appropriating the funds received from sources not anticipated as hereinbefore recited and the same are budgeted and appropriated to the items and sections of the budget, by increasing the following items:




Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage, approval and legal publication.

PASSED by the City Council on the 28 day of August, 1962, and signed in authentication of its passage this 28 day of August 1962.


