ORDINANCE NO. 552

ORIGINAL

AN ORDINANCE relating to the licensing of cabarets; and amending Chapter 5.32 of Bellevue City Code.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON,
DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 5.32.030 of Bellevue City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

5.32.030 License prohibited to certain classes.

No license shall be issued to:

1. A natural person who has not attained the age of twenty-one years, or who is not of good moral character.
2. A natural person who has been convicted of a felony within five years prior to filing his application.
3. A person whose place of business is conducted by a manager or agent, unless such manager or agent possesses the same qualifications required of the licensee.
4. A co-partnership, unless all the members thereof shall be qualified to obtain a license as provided in this chapter.
5. A corporation, unless all of the officers and directors thereof shall be qualified to obtain a license as provided herein. Such license shall be issued to the manager or agent thereof.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage, approval and legal publication.
